

this program works!! I started this DVD set when my son was 19mo, he is now 22 months and knows all his letters, the sounds they make, and can recognize them anywhere. At 1st I think he was memorizing them until we were out and he started pointing to the letters and saying the sounds and names! it comes with flash cards, and workbooks. I never used the work books, only the flash cards and the 2 DVDs that come with the kit. its so good of a program that my 22mo is bored now with the letters he knows them all and now i'm going to move onto the next kit which is kindergarten level. WORTH THE BUY, ITS GREAT

I am really big On Hooked on Phonics. It really helped my now eight year-old learn to read really well. I bought this for my younger son who I was trying to teach letter sounds to, and I was really disappointed! While the textbook focused on both the names and sounds of the letters, the cd rom game focused on letter names only and not the sounds. Personally, I think the cd rom games are key to concretely reinforcing what is learned in the textbook. Then, when you move on to Hooked On Phonics, Kindergarten Edition, it is assumed your child largely knows all the letter sounds. There's a big hole in phonics skills between the Pre-K and Kindergarten Editions, in my opinion. Maybe I relied to much on the cd rom, but when I bought the Kindergarten and First Grade Editions, that was a big asset in those editions that I strongly relied on for reinforcement.

My three year old is mostly done with this set. She is about two thirds through book two and we have been taking our time with it. But so far, I can say I see the results. It's a very basic concept that you could probably design in your own home school setting but it was definitely worth the purchase. The only reason I won't give five stars is because it is boring at times and I find it difficult to keep my toddler's attention for the entire unit that it wants you to do at a time, so I've had to modify it. The books are also irrelevant at times, except for one, and serve little to support the lesson other than

reading itself. The dvd's are catchy to an almost obnoxious point and you can tell they were made in the 90's.... But she loves them and all the songs. What really irked me was that book two is essentially the exact same thing as book one - except with lowercase letters added in. Same goes for the dvd's. They're the same except with slight changes. The letter songs ate also repeated, for example, one song is for two or three letters. Overall she's happy though and I see results. Don't expect anything over the top amazing, but it really does its job.

My daughter and my son are doing this phonics and they both enjoy it while learning at the same time. My daughter started this when she was in preschool when she was 4. My husband always doing the teaching privately so they can concentrate. I tell you this, it works! Our son is kinda a little late but he is learning throu this phonics. He didnot learn from other books but this. I am very happy to purchase this product. You should get one if youo have kids.

I know that this system works I've used it with my own children. This set is for my 2yr old Granddaughter and we're anxious to start working with her. We opted for the lesser expensive set without the 'online' features listed since she is only 2, but it came today and I'm excited to say, it's included in our package! We can't wait!
