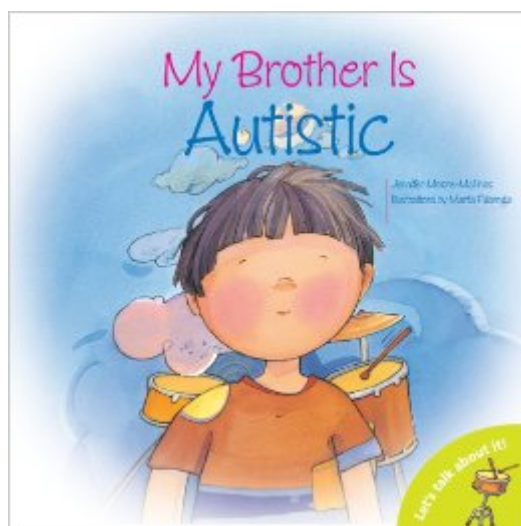

This book does a nice job illustrating what autism MAY look like to a sib. I held back one star because I felt that it should have addressed MORE of a variety of issues that sibs may deal with-providing more of a talking point for parents.

*My Brother is Autistic* is a lovely book that deals with the difficulties siblings often face when they have a brother/sister with Autism. The authors sensitively approaches the topic from both the perspective of the sibling and the child with autism, making this a very useful tool for parents, teachers or psychologists like myself.

Right now she doesn't have the attention span or comprehension to follow along with this book. Like another reviewer mentioned, "being embarrassed" is not something she recognizes as an emotion just yet, she just knows her brother is different and different isn't wrong.
