## Customer Reviews

Our California school ordered this set of early readers hoping to support the youngest students with the expectations of the Common Core Standards. We anticipated the arrival of a large box of the colorful readers as portrayed in this picture. Instead, a box, slightly larger than a shoebox, was delivered containing thin booklets, with plain, faded pastel-colored covers. The books had neither colorful illustrations on the covers nor on the pages within. Instead the pages contained stick-figure characters on black and white pages. Disappointed is a mild expression describing our teachers' reaction. The text of full sentences was exceptionally uninspiring. Be forewarned.

I don't normally leave feedback, but in this case I thought I should. I read a lot of the reviews for this product on [Amazon](#) and I think some of the negative comments may discourage people from buying these

books - I know I almost didn't buy them. It turns out that many of the negative feedback that I saw (books are too small, stories are too short, black and white pictures only) turned out to be fabulous positives for my daughter. The size is great for her little-ish hands, the stories are short enough to keep her attention for the purpose (engage her in the print and the story), the word use within the stories (repeating, rhyming, themed) are helping her learn to recognize sounds and letters, and the black and white illustrations keep it simple and are not distracting - I like how she looks at the letters as I'm running my finger along the bottom of words. She certainly did comment on the fact that the images were black and white, and not in color, but I took the cue from another reviewer and told my daughter that we could color the pictures any time she wanted to, and that was sufficient for us to move on with the reading. I have to say I am 100% happy with this purchase and I think the books will be very helpful in turning my daughter into a reader. I'm glad I read the positive reviews, otherwise I would have missed out on these awesome teaching tools.

These are so cheap. I know the price is low for 60 books but I still expected more. Its very small, flimsy paper books. You can see a staple holding it intact. There is no color on the pages. Much smaller than a typical children's book. I am definitely disappointed. I will be cutting apart the books, laminating the pages and tying them together with ribbon to make it more durable. They are just too easily ruined as they are.

PLEASE don't let all the negative comments deter you from buying these. Yes, the books are very small, yes they are short and yes they are in B&W. All to help your child focus with minimal distractions. Also, you're paying less than \$20 for 60 books; what did you expect? My daughter is 5 and has been reading for quite some time, but gets overwhelmed and discouraged when so much is going on and when there's so many words. She was so excited to start these. There's 4 diff levels, 15 books in each level, so she decided she wanted to read 5 a day and has been doing awesome with them. They're short enough to keep her focused and not frustrated but still challenge her. And I read another reviewer say you can color the pictures when they're done reading. That's a great idea and got my daughter even more excited. Two products for the price of one! I would def recommend these!!

**BEWARE - READ DESCRIPTION!!!! THESE ARE NOT BOOKS!!!!** These are CHEAPLY MADE tiny booklets!!!! The cost (\$4.98) to return them was more than they were worth....

Purchased this set for around \$28 and I am very pleased with it. Many people are complaining because the actual stories are not in color. That is to minimize distractions for a beginning reader. My son is able to focus on the words he is supposed to be reading and not the pictures. Very happy with this purchase.

I was disappointed when receiving these books today. They don't come in a box, but a zip lock bag. Then I am looking through them and they are only black and white photos throughout and the pages feel like something I could of ran off on my printer and stapled a thin piece of cardboard over. :(

These books are perfect for beginner readers. I have read some reviews about how they arrived in a plastic bag and cheaply made. I have to disagree. I love that they are simple and easy for my 6 yr old to hold and point. Also, you receive 60 books in a bag. That's cheaper than you would pay from any other retailer. We put the books in a small crate by the bed. LOVE LOVE LOVE these books. Way better than the BOB books I purchased and only received 10 of.
