

Synopsis

Daily Prayer is the first daily prayer book in the Church of England's history. It contains a Daily Office - a collection of orders of service designed to be prayed at different points through the day. The services may be prayed individually, in groups, churches or in religious communities. Drawing on the daily Bible readings laid out in the Common Worship Lectionary, they allow Anglicans to link their personal devotions into the shared prayer life of the Church. As well as the more traditional services of Morning, Evening, and Night Prayer, Daily Prayer also offers Prayer During the Day, especially designed for those new to regular liturgical prayer. Each service contains the three key elements of praise, intercession and engagement with Scripture. Prayers are included for both Ordinary Time and the seasons of the Christian year. It contains: The Calendar Prayer During the Day Forms of Penitence Morning and Evening Prayer Night Prayer (Compline) Prayers of Intercession The Litany Collects and Refrains Canticles The Psalter The Lord's Prayer and Apostles' Creed on the inside back cover for quick reference

Why no lectionary? A brief description of the current CofE Lectionary is necessary. There are effectively three different lectionaries:One is for use on Sundays, assigning readings for principal, secondary, and tertiary services. The second is for use in Daily Prayer, morning and evening. This lectionary is intended for use in places such are your home or monastic communities where the same group of people are either following the lectionary privately or attending services every day,

morning and evening. This lectionary follows a 'long narrative' of the Church seasons. The third is for use in place of the second in places where it is necessary to have readings which follow the Church seasons, but are thematically able to stand alone; for example, a large Church or Cathedral with great numbers of fluctuating visitors. To complicate matters even further, the first and second lecitonaries mentioned above are on a three-year cycle. The complete lectionary is quite complicated, and would be difficult to follow on a daily basis. For this reason the CofE publishes a yearly lectionary which lists the various readings for each calendar day of the year. To give you a sense, the Advent of 2013 through Trinitytide of 2014 lectionary is an 88-page stand alone volume. For the time it saves, purchasing this inexpensive lectionary volume each year is entirely worth it.

This is a very attractive edition of the Daily Prayer book for use in the Church of England. The cover features the title "Daily Prayer" slightly debossed (indented into the surface), and overall the book fits nicely in your hand. The paper quality seems like it is perhaps a little on the cheap side, but not bad. Everything is the same as the regular edition and is available for viewing online at the C of E website. Overall, it's a good purchase for anyone who desires to pray the Daily Office according to the use of the Church of England.

The issue that I have with this book is the Seller's claim that it is bound in "soft touch leather". It is made of some kind of vinyl, and should be identified as such.

My book arrived with a bit of black gunk on the front cover.
