

DISCLAIMER: I was one of the technical reviewers of the book. With that said, if I was not one of the reviewers. I would have been one of the beta book customers. The reason is that the author is one of those rare human beings who can explain things to you just as effectively in a book form as he can over a more interactive medium. And this book is no exception. It is the best resource out there if you are looking to either learn or improve your ability to test drive Rails applications. But that's not where it stops. The book is filled with nuggets of useful information that comes from the author's experience in the field & specifically with test driven design (TDD). The book starts with a very balanced view towards testing. It emphasizes that accuracy is an important attribute to have in tests but clarifies that TDD is more of a software design technique with verification as a side effect. The author does a wonderful job in identifying which of the reasons that are generally used as a benefit of TDD are useful based on his experience. Even though the book is about TDD, the author does a wonderful job identifying situations where TDD is not going to be effective. The author's explanations on what makes great tests is probably one of my favorite sections in the book and a great example why this book is useful for programmers building applications outside of the Rails framework. The previous edition of this book was the resource that clarified the difference between mocks & stubs for me and this version improves upon that. Furthermore, the book does a wonderful job of exploring how to test applications for different goals & different contexts. This is the most thorough resource on the subject of test driving Rails Applications that I am aware of. You should definitely buy this book!

I bought this book thinking it would just make a "good read", but I was way off: it became the book I couldn't put down. I literally wore out the page corners from constantly reading and referencing such a rich collection of testing knowledge. The title is about test prescriptions, but the subtitle says it all. Through this book, Noel showed me how to write great tests, that in turn caused me write better code. My code wasn't the only code to improve. This book was very instrumental in introducing my co-workers to testing, and helped guide them through the process with ease. Rails 4 Test Prescriptions has been worth far more to me than what I paid for it: I had no idea how valuable this book would become.

If you are a rails developer and want to be able to sleep well at night, this book is for you. This book has so much to offer and definitely is a must have money and/or reputation is at stake. It will take you through the automated testing world of mocks, stubs, spies plus teach you how to setup your fixtures using factory girl. It also covers integration testing using cucumber

I have found this book to be invaluable, and I frankly think it is equally valuable for even the most experienced Rails developers. In Rails 4 Test Prescriptions, Rappin covers nearly every way to test your Rails apps, allowing you to achieve borderline excessive test coverage (although he does not encourage that, and instead offers instruction in how to improve test performance and avoid repetition). With a droll sense of humor that helps make the book accessible, Rappin keeps the reader engaged while providing in-depth discussions and examples of tests for all aspects of Rails apps, including security and JavaScript. Reading this book has made testing nearly painless and helped me understand how, why, and what to test, leading to far less brittle code.

Its an awesome book, led me to tdd and bdd way, seamlessly.

Rails 4 Test Prescriptions is a well written book about the current state of Ruby/Rails testing. If you are new to Rails/Ruby testing world, this book is invaluable.
