

The printed volumes for Ordinary Time include the complementary stream during Year A, the complementary stream during the first half of Year B, the semicontinuous stream during the second half of Year B, and the semicontinuous stream during Year C. Beginning with the season after Pentecost in Year C, the alternate lections for Ordinary Time not in the print volumes will be available online at [feastingontheword.net](http://feastingontheword.net).

I bought a few other volumes of this for my Kindle and this one is just as wonderful. While I prefer a real book, having the entire set of "Feasting on the Word" on an e-reader is a great way to purchase these without the significant cost of the hard covers. Being one who only occasionally preaches, these are invaluable resources.

Though I do not typically like to use a lectionary for my sermon preparation, when a pastor gets "stuck" in a rut, a book like this is a great help. This book lays out a logical way to move through the scriptures during the course of the year. Even if a pastor does not want to follow the entire book, just using the 6 weeks before Christmas and Easter can help the pastor break out of the same old stuff that is often presented at those times of the year. Well done, worth the price.

As always I have found the ideas and scholarship in these works helpful in the study of scriptures in the lectionary for each Sunday in the liturgical year. I find the series to be a springboard for ideas in helping prepare for the worship service for each week.

As a preacher, I found this book and this series a great resource in sermon preparation. To have four different perspectives on each lectionary passage really helps, no matter what theological perspective brings you to the preaching task.

This is an excellent aid for preparing sermons based on the lectionary text. Even though there are no sample sermons, this is the first place I go to get my bearings on the text. Each of the lectionary texts are examined from four perspectives by experts in their field: theological, pastoral, homiletical, and exegetical. Feasting on the Word is a multi volume set that covers the church year for each of the three lectionary cycles. Thankfully they are available on kindle for a reduced price. And yes, these volumes are a feast!

I absolutely LOVE this series of Feasting on the Word. They are an excellent source of information for preparing sermons, meditations, etc.. I cannot wait to complete the series by purchasing all of Year C.
